

"Turbowars" is committed to ensuring your security. We have created this Privacy Policy to outline to you how we operate with respect to the personal information (as described below) that we collect from customers of our website <https://turbowars.io/> and online administrations (by and large, the "Administration").

1. Types of Data We Collect.

"Personal Data" is information that enables us to recognize or reach you, such as your name, address, telephone number, email address, and other non-public data about you that is related or linked to the aforementioned information. "Unidentified Data" is information, including collected and unidentified information, that is not related to your Personal Information; anonymous data does not allow us to infer the identity of individuals without outside assistance. We collect personal data and anonymous data as shown below.

1. a Data you provide to us.

1. We may collect Personal Data from you, such as your first and last name, email and home number, Ethereum address, and Turbowars secret code, when you create a record to log in to our organization ("Account").
2. If you use our Services on your cell phone, we may collect your phone number and interesting device ID number.
3. Our Service allows you to save settings such as how your content is displayed, your environment, secure search settings, notification settings, and most popular devices. We may associate these choices with your ID, program, or cell phone, and you may change these settings at any time.
4. If you connect to our services through a special co-op that particularly identifies your cell phone, we can get that ID and utilize it to offer advanced administrations as well as usefulness.
5. Certain services, for example, two-factor verification, may require us to select your telephone number. We may link this phone number to your cell phone ID data.
6. If you provide us with criticism or reach out to us via email, we collect your name and email address, and other information stored for the email in order to send you a response.
7. We likewise gather different sorts of personal data that you intentionally give us, for example, your working environment and customization, item registration number, Ethereum address, and other mentioned data, when you get in touch with us by email to get help for the Services.
8. We may likewise collect Personal Data at various points on our Service that indicate that Personal Data is being collected.

1. b Data collected through technology.

When you explore and connect to our Service, we may utilize programmed information gathering innovations to gather specific data about your hardware, usage activities, and examples:

1. **Data collected by our servers.** To make our Service more valuable to you, our servers (which may be supported by a third party data gathering organization) collect data from you, including your program type, work framework, Internet Protocol ("IP") address (a number assigned to your PC when you use the Internet that may fluctuate from session to session), room name, Ethereum address, wallet type, or possibly a date/time stamp for your visit.
2. **Log Files.** As is common with most websites, we naturally collect certain data and store it in log files. This data includes IP addresses, program type, Internet Service Provider ("ISP"), accessing/exiting pages, work frames, date/time stamp, and clickstream information. We use this data to analyze patterns, monitor the service, track customer trends around the service, gather segment data about our customer base in general, and better tailor our services to our customers' needs. For example, some of the data might be collected to help the Service remember you when you visit, and the data might then be used to provide promotions and other data that match your inclinations.
3. **Cookies** As with other web-based services, we use "cookies" to collect data. "cookies" are small snippets of data that a website places on your PC's hard drive while you are visiting the website. We may use both session cookies (which expire as soon as you close your Internet browser) and "cookies" to collect data.
4. **Pixel Tag.** We additionally use "pixel tags" (also referred to as clear gifs, web guides, or web bugs). Pixel tags are small realistic images with an interesting identifier, comparable to cookies used to track online developments of web customers. In contrast to cookies, which are saved on the client's hard drive, pixel tags are installed unnoticed in web pages. Pixel tags also allow us to send email messages in a configuration that is understandable to the customer, and they let us know if the messages have been opened to ensure that we only send messages that are important to our customers. We may use this data to reduce or stop sending messages to a customer. We do not link the data collected by Pixel Tags to our customers' personal information.
5. **How we respond to Do Not Track signals.** We do not currently respond to "Do Not Track" signals or other components that may allow users to stop tracking on our website.
6. **Analytics Services.** Notwithstanding the following innovations that we employ, other organizations may employ their own procedures or comparable devices when you visit our Service. This includes outside examination services, including but not limited to Google ("Analytics Services"), with whom we are associated to analyze how customers use the Service. We may receive reports that depend on the use of these devices by these groups on an individual or aggregate basis. We use the data we receive from analytics services only to work on our Service. The data generated by the cookies or other advancements about your use of our Service (the "Investigation Information") is

sent to the Analytics Services. The Analytics Services use Analytics Information to compile information about customer movements. The Analytics Services may also share data with outside parties if required to do so by law or if those outside parties process the Analytics Information for their own purposes. The ability of each Analytics Service to use and share Analytics Information is limited by the terms of use and privacy policy of that Analytics Service. By using our Service, you consent to Analytics Services processing information about you in the manner and for the reasons described above. 1. c Data Collected from Third Party Companies.

We may receive personally identifiable or potentially anonymous information about you from organizations that provide our types of support through a jointly tagged or privately named website, or from organizations that offer their items and additional services through our Service. In particular, MetaMask and other Wallets provide us with your Ethereum address and certain other data that you provide to MetaMask and other Wallets. These external organizations might provide us with personal data. We might add this data to the data we have already collected from you through our Service in order to develop it. We do not collect Personal Data, of course, but we may link the data we collect through it to Personal Data about you that we receive from other sources or that you give to us.

2. Use of your personal data

2. a General Uses. Generally, the personal information you provide to us is used to respond to your requests or to help us serve you better. We use your personal information in the following ways:

1. To work in creating and securing your account with our organization;
2. To distinguish you as a customer in our framework;
3. to further develop our service;
4. to provide the types of support you request, including but not limited to working with your cryptographic wallets through MetaMask (<https://metamask.io>) or other wallets;
5. Process the type of involvement when you connect to our Service;
6. Send you a welcome email to confirm responsibility for the email address you provided when creating your account;
7. To protect you and other customers from any conduct that violates the Terms of Service or to prevent abuse or provocation of a customer;
8. To display your username near the computerized resources you choose to sell on the Site;
9. Send you authoritative email notifications, such as security or support alerts;
10. Send you email alerts related to activities in the Service, thinking about offers for your enhanced resources;
11. Respond to your requests related to offers of work or other solicitations;

12. to make telephone decisions with you from time to time, as part of optional blackmail security or to request your criticism;
13. in any other way we may present if you provide the personal information; and
14. to send bulletins, reviews, offers, and other time-limited materials in connection with our Services and for other promotional purposes for Turbowars.
15. We may use your Personal Data to contact you about our own and others' work and products that may be relevant to you.

2. b Anonymous Data.

We may create Anonymous Data sets from Personal Data by excluding data (such as your name) that makes the information identifiable to you. We use this Anonymous Data to investigate solicitation and usage patterns with the goal of improving the substance of our services and advancing the service path. We claim all authority to utilize Anonymous Data for any purpose and to disclose Anonymous Data to outsiders without restriction.

3. Disclosure of Your Personal Data.

We disclose your Personal Data as set forth below and as described elsewhere in this Privacy Policy.

3.a External Service Providers. We may share your personal information with outside specialized organizations in order to: Provide you with the services we offer through our Service; perform quality confirmation testing; work with record keeping; provide specialized assistance; and provide various types of support to Turbowars.

3.b Affiliates We may share some or all of your Personal Information with our parent company, subsidiaries, joint ventures, or other organizations under common control ("Affiliates"), in which case we require our Affiliates to comply with this Privacy Policy.

3.c Corporate Restructuring. We may exchange or share some or all of your Personal Information in connection with or during the course of consolidation, financing, procurement or dissolution, including a closing, relocation, divestiture, or disclosure of all or a portion of our business or resources. In the event of debt, insolvency, or bankruptcy, personal information may also be moved as a business resource. If another organization acquires our organization, business or resources, that organization will have the personal information we collect and will expect the freedoms and obligations set forth in this Privacy Policy with respect to your personal information.

3.d As Legally Required. Notwithstanding any choices you make with respect to your Personal Information (as set forth below), Turbowars may disclose Personal Information if it sincerely believes that such disclosure is essential (a) in pursuit of a lawful investigation; (b) to comply with important laws or to respond to subpoenas or warrants served on Turbowars; (c) to secure or protect the privileges or property of Turbowars or customers of the Service; and (d) to prevent violations or likely violations of the law, this Privacy Policy or our Terms of Use.

3.e Other Disclosures. We may also disclose your personal information to fulfill the reason you provided it; for another reason, we disclosed when you provided it; or with your consent. We do not sell your personal information.

4. Third-Party Websites.

Our Service may contain links to third-party websites. When you click on a connection to another site or area, you are leaving our Service and going to another site, and another element may collect personal information or anonymous information from you. You may also see commercial centers fueled by the Service on other sites. We have no control over these external sites or their content, do not monitor them and cannot be held responsible for them. Please be advised that the terms of this Privacy Policy do not materially affect these external sites or content or any selection of your personal information when you click on links to such external sites. We strongly recommend that you review the security policies of any site you visit. Links to outside sites or areas are for your convenience and do not imply that we endorse those outside sites or their articles, content, or pages.

5. Third-Party Wallet Extensions

We use third-party electronic wallet extensions, such as (but not limited to) MetaMask, to manage the exchange of digital currencies; your connections with MetaMask or potentially any third-party electronic wallet extensions are managed through the appropriate security procedures. 6. Your choices regarding information.

You have some options regarding the use of information in our Services:

6.a Email Communications.

We will occasionally send you free, selected brochures and news items that promote the use of our service in a simple way. If you receive bulletins or special correspondence from us, you may show an inclination not to receive further communications from us, and you will have the option to "opt-out" by following the opt-out policy stated in the email you receive or by contacting us directly (if it is not too much trouble, see contact information in section (1)). Turbowars will verify that you are able to reach this email, and then delete the data associated with your email address. We will endeavor to respond to your request within 7 days, and in any event within 28 days of receipt of the request.

Correction of Information. You may change your personal information on your settings page.

8. Retention of Information.

We may retain your Personal Information for as long as you use the Service, have a record with us, or for as long as is important to fulfill the reasons set forth in this Privacy Policy. You may request deletion of your record by reaching out to us as described above, and we will delete your Personal Data upon request. In any event, we may retain your Personal Information for as long as permitted or required by relevant laws, for legal, chargeable or administrative reasons, or for genuine and lawful business purposes.

9. Protection of Information.

We are concerned about the security of your information and use physical, authoritative and mechanical safeguards to ensure the trustworthiness and security of all information collected through our website. Nonetheless, no security framework is invulnerable and we cannot guarantee the security of our frameworks 100%. In the event that data within our control is compromised due to a security breach, we will find ways to investigate the circumstances and, where appropriate, notify the individuals whose data has been compromised and take other actions consistent with relevant laws and policies.

A Note About Children.

We do not intentionally collect Personal Information from guests younger than 13 years of age. If a child under the age of 13 submits Personal Information to Turbowars and we determine that the Personal Information came from a child under the age of 13, we will make every effort to delete the information as soon as possible. If you believe that we have Personal Data from a child under 13, please contact us at the address listed in Section 1.

A Note to Users Outside the United States. In the event that you are a non-U.S. customer of the Service, by visiting the Service and submitting information, you acknowledge and agree that your Personal Data may be processed for the reasons set forth in the Privacy Policy. In addition, your personal data may be processed in the country where it was collected and in other countries, including the United States, where the laws regarding the processing of personal data may be less strict than in your country. By providing your information, you consent to such sharing.
